News From Next STEP!

June was such a fun and educational month in Next STEP! For our community navigation portion of the curriculum, the participants researched how to get to downtown Portland by the Metro as well as how much to budget for a round trip. Then, each Wednesday, they took the bus to Monument Square where they explored the Portland Public Market and compared prices of items there to those that might be purchased at Hannafords. Additional Metro trips to explore the downtown will be scheduled throughout the summer.

Next STEP also recently took a tour of EcoMaine which is the largest recycling facility in Maine. We learned what single-sort recycling means and what happens to the things that we recycle. When we saw all of what is recycled (approx. 35,550 tons annually!!) it helped us to have a better understanding of the importance of doing our part.



In addition to our regular curriculum-based activities of volunteering, exercise and the M.O.G., and our weekly food lab, Next STEP is taking advantage of the beautiful weather. Upcoming trips and activities will include: a trip to Mackworth Island in Falmouth, taking in a Sea Dogs game, a beach scavenger hunt and so much more!

As you are making plans for your fall schedule, Next STEP is a great option offering quality curriculum for those that are on a waiting list for other services, in combination with other services or for those who may not qualify for other service.
